Dear Parents,

I am very much looking forward to the Academy of the Most Blessed Sacrament Christmas Concert on **Wednesday, December 12th at both 1:30 pm and 6:00 pm!**

Please know that all grades will be participating in the Christmas Concert. Students in the PK3 and PK4 will only be participating in the afternoon performance. Students in Transitions through 8th grade will participate in both the afternoon and evening performances. It is expected that all students will share their talents for this occasion. For anyone unable to attend one or both of the performances, an alternate assessment will be given. Please see me for more information if you know in advance that you will not be in attendance.

I ask that all students wear their "Sunday best" for the concert. It is recommended that girls wear skirts and blouses or a dress of appropriate length, and the boys wear a shirt and tie. **Please no jeans, leggings, boots, or sneakers!** There is no specific requirement in regard to colors. Be sure that students are comfortable in their attire so as to minimize difficulty in moving on and off the stage. Students should come to school in their attire for the concert. There will not be time for the students to change during the school day.

On the night of the performance, students should arrive **no later than 5:30 pm in the gym** to warm up and be in their places. Older students will be assisting younger students, so it is vital that everyone arrive promptly.
