



The Scholarship Fund for Inner-City Children (SFIC) Invites Families to Apply for Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance is based on financial need and is awarded without regard to ethnicity, gender, race or religion.

Some awards may not be transferable to another school or family member.

Currently the SFIC General Scholarship Fund awards partial tuition assistance to elementary and high school students entering grades K through 12. **(Pre-Kindergarten programs are not eligible.)**

Applications open on March 1, 2026.

Deadline for submitting your online application with all required documents is May 1, 2026.

The following is required for the application:

- Signed 2025 Federal 1040 form (pages 1 & 2), listing each child for whom you are requesting assistance.
- All 2025 W-2 forms for every wage earner in the household
- \$35 non-refundable application fee payable to SFIC.
- A valid email address for all SFIC communications.
